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# SUVARNPRASHANA – ANNUAL REPORT FOR YEAR 2023 BASED ON OBSERVATIONAL STUDY IN CHILDREN

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#### ABSTRACT

Children are born with an immature immune system, hence are at risk from many pathogens.<sup>[1]</sup> India has the highest number of child births as well as child deaths for any single nation in the world and infectious diseases is one of the important causes of child death. Concept of Immunity in Ayurveda can be understood through concept of *Vyadhikshamatva*. Which can be achieved by protective and preventive measure. *Suvarnprashana* is an ayurvedic blessing which is traditionally given to small children. It is one of the preventive measure mention by *Acharya Kashyap*, which helps children to boost up the intellectual power and produces non-specific immunity in the body to fight against general infections and disorders. *Suvarnprashana* in children can be mainly implicated in two context of Ayurveda; *Lehana* (Supplementary feeds) and *Jatakarma Samskara* (new born care). *Suvarnaprashana* can be given from birth to sixteen years, keeping in mind the rapid growth and development during this phase of life. Clinically, a minimum therapy of 6 months, 1 year to two years is recommended in order to get considerable results. Ayurvedic physicians administer *Suvarnprashana* on the day of *Pushya Nakshatra* of every month. So, after every 27th day on *Pushya Nakshatra* of every month we should administer *Suvarnprashana* to the children. In the year 2023, a total of 2332 children of age 0-16 years were given the beneficiary of *Suvarnprashana* in *Suvarnprashana Shivir* organised by P.G. Department of Kaumarbhritya Rishikul Campus, Haridwar.

## SUVARNPRASHANA AT RISHIKUL CAMPUS

- It has been started at Rishikul campus in the year 2018. Since then, *Suvarnprashana* has been administered once in a month at Rishikul Campus Uttarakhand Ayurved University, Haridwar for children between 0 to 16 years on the day of *Pushya nakshtra*.
- Children accompanied by their parents will report at the registration counter. A card is handed over with registration number containing detail about name, age, date of birth, address along with parent's name. After that they will report to the OPD to determine the height, weight and the same will be entered into card, any illness and its duration also documented.
- All the parents are advised not to give any food to child for one hour after administration of *Suvarnprashana*.
- Suvarnprashana was started on 4/ Jan/ 2018 at Rishikul Campus, UAU, Haridwar, total number of 77 cycles of *Suvarnaprashana*, and total 11,202 entries were reported till December 2023.
- In the year **2023**, total **2332** children were given *Suvarnaprashana* drops.



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



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#### DISCUSSION

Suvarnaprashana is a comprehensive Rasayana Chikitsa, administered for the physical, mental, intellectual and spiritual wellbeing of the children. It can be safely administered in infants and children up to 16 years of age. Suvaranprashana was prepared by adding Suvarana bhasma in Siddha Ghrita containing Brahmi, Vacha, Yashtimadhu etc. along with madhu. They have Balya, Rasayana, Medhya and Tridoshamaka properties. Swarna bhasma, the principal ingredient enhance immunity, Brahmi, Vacha are effective in improvement of memory and lack of attention, Yasthimadhu is good anti-inflammatory, analgesic and antioxidant. According to ancient texts, Regular use of Suvarnaprashana for 1 month boosts the memory & for 6 months enhances the retention power.

The dose of *Suvaranprashana* was decided on the basis of age of child. The assessment was done on the scale of physical growth and its respiratory, digestion and mental health effect.

#### CONCLUSION

Suvarnaprashan Samskar offers multidimensional Protection of child. It can increases child's immunity and intellectual strength. Gold has anti-aging property (Rasayana) and site specific drug targeting potential. This wonderful drug has been used by Ayurvedic physician to safe guard the health of children by Suvaranprashana can be securely administered in infant and children up to 16 years of age for their physical, mental and intellectual wellbeing. The study concludes that maximum percent of relieve in respiratory difficulty in age group 6- 10 years, maximum relive in G.I.T. symptoms in age group 6- 10 years, maximum relieve in mental health in age group 0-5 years. There is urgent need of standardizing the preparation, dose, duration and method of administration.
